### Vineyard and Winemaking Notes

Nestled in the Sierra foothills at an elevation of 1083', Fraser Family Vineyards has proven to be an ideal location for growing several premium grape varietals. In a community of wineries, less than one acre is planted with Dolcetto alongside three other varietals.

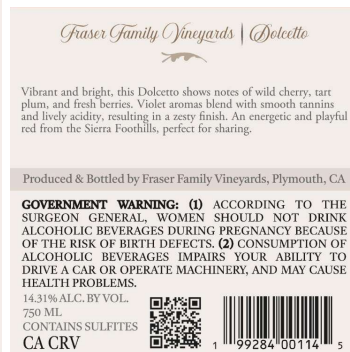
The 2024 harvest was timed to perfectly capture the sugar and acid levels for our beautiful Dolcetto wine. During fermentation, this wine was a pleasure to produce. The bright color and aroma of rock candy filled the winery during maceration.

### Tasting Notes

Dolcetto translates to "little sweet one," a reference to its lower acidity compared to other varieties, also originating from the Piedmont region. Our Sierra Foothills Dolcetto is a delicious example of this important but lesser-produced varietal. Vibrant and bright, this Dolcetto shows notes of wild cherry, tart plum, and fresh berries. Violet aromas blend with smooth tannins and lively acidity, resulting in a zesty finish. An energetic and playful red from the Sierra Foothills, perfect for sharing.
